- Under the General Options, add a suitable name for the Quiz. In the FCMS final exams, the format is,

"Final Online Assessment - <Course code>"

If you need any description to add, you can add it to the "Description" box

- The next option is, "Timing"
- In oder to add timing, you need to enable Open and Close quiz timing first.
- Then add relavent timing for opening and closing the quiz. And also set the **Time limit.**

**Example:** Suppose our assessement duration is two hours and it's a morning exam. So the exam open time should be 9 am and the Close time should be 11. 10 am. This additional **10 minutes** we reserve for any unaviodable technical issues. (Anyway students will get only two hours for the exam).

In the "When time expires" field, select "Open attempts are sublitted automatically" option.

- Under the "Grade", keep the Grade category as "Uncategorized" (as we don't have grade categories in the EVAL page.)
- Attempts allowed should be 1.

- Under the "Layout", select "Every question" under New page.
- Navigation method should be "Free".

Under the "Question behaviour", you can enable Shuffle within questions, based on your question types.

Under the "Review options", we do not select any option in FCMS final exams. Deselect all the options. (For other exams and assessments, you may select relevant Review options accordingly).



• Under the "Appearance", keep all the default settings as it is.

 Under the "Safe Exam Browser", select No. (for postgraduate exams, you may require to enable this option).

- Under "Extra restrictions on attempts", you may enter a password for the quiz. In FCMS final exams we do not enter passwords for the quiz.
- Under the "Browser security" select "Full screen pop-up with some JavaScript security" option.
- If "Full screen pop-up with some JavaScript security" option is selected,
  - The quiz appears in a full screen popup window that covers all the windows and has no navigation controls.
  - Students are prevented, as far as is possible, from using facilities like **copy and paste**.

Following browsers are by default enabled the Java Security.

- The next feature is the, "Restrict access"
- The restrict access feature enables us to restrict the availability of the Quiz, according to certain conditions such as dates, grade obtained, group or activity completion.
- Click on **"Add restrictions"**.



• For the FCMS final exams, we use "Date" condition to prevent access until the exam date and the time.
